

## Call for Papers

### *Special Invitation for papers presented at the ISAHP2020 Dec. 3-6 virtual conference*

The purpose of this call for papers is to collect a high-quality selection of papers presented at the [ISAHP2020](#) virtual conference that will take place Dec. 3-6, 2020. IJAHHP is the official AHP/ANP scholarly, SCOPUS-indexed online journal (<https://www.ijahp.org>), that publishes papers about research and applications of the Analytic Hierarchy Process (AHP) and Analytic Network Process (ANP). The IJAHHP journal will support the ISAHP2020 meeting by offering a *fast-track*<sup>1</sup> publication opportunity for suitable papers. Our intention is to publish these papers as early as possible. They will still go through the usual rigorous review process of the journal to be accepted for publication. When an author submits a paper to our [IJAHHP site](#), it should be formatted according to the journal requirements, explained in the author guidelines, and uploaded to the IJAHHP "Special Topics" section (not "Articles" or "Essays"). Also, there is a "Comments to the Editor" place for the author to indicate that the study was presented in ISAHP 2020, if this were the case.

**Submission Deadlines:** Rolling basis until September 30, 2021

- Submission papers must not have been previously published or be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- Acceptance will be provided on rolling basis.
- Submitted papers must be formatted according to IJAHHP guidelines available at the journal website.

<sup>1</sup> By *fast track* we mean that papers will be assigned for review to selected IJAHHP/ISAHP senior reviewers with the request to provide reviews within a short timeframe. Also, accepted papers will be scheduled to be published in the special topics section of the most immediate upcoming issue.
