### AHP/ANP: The Next Generation

Our [ISAHP2020](#) conference theme reflects the idea that the moment has come for a new generation of scholars and practitioners to take the lead with AHP/ANP. The ISAHP2020 virtual format has been decided in the context of the “new normal” we live in. A virtual meeting constitutes a new delivery format but that most likely will become the predominant model for international academic meetings. It has the advantage to make it possible for a larger number of participants to present their work since the time and costs associated are significantly lower than in a physical event. For this reason, we believe this is the ideal opportunity to attract younger AHP/ANP professionals that may not have attended previous meetings.

Interested AHP/ANP participants will submit a 1-3 page extended summary/abstract paper following [the ISAHP2020 submission guidelines](#) available in the conference website. The paper length will depend on the nature of the submission: completed research, research in progress and research proposals will be considered for the symposium.
